NIGHT PATROL reserved off the rail, raced in traffic around the second turn, angled out for the drive, challenged inside the final furlong and proved best late. IMPASSABLE CANYON four wide early, moved up three wide on the second turn, challenged once in the stretch and held on gamely. LEW AND MIKE behind the leaders three wide, moved in a path on the second turn, gained a short lead with a furlong to go and held on gamely. TAKEPOINTSANDRUN within striking distance along the inside, lacked a rally. MELLOW FELLOW alternated for the lead along the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. PURGING THE STONE outrun along the inside, was off the rail on the second turn and could not threaten. XINGU vied for the lead off the inside and tired in the drive. MANGIA TROPPO was no factor.
