CLOSING RANGE attended the pace along the inside, shifted out leaving the second turn, split rivals and wore down the leaders inside the furlong marker. CORLEONE pressed the pace three wide, drew even leaving the second turn, poked her head in front with a furlong to run but was unable to resist the winner. DO THE CHARLESTON was allowed to settle, moved up four wide to make her bid, but lacked the needed late response. TELLER TERRI settled saving ground, ranged into striking distance on the second turn, got through entering the stretch and continued on well between horses. JAZIL'S SONG was allowed to settle, split horses and was making up ground too late. TEENY LIZ was close up four wide to the stretch and tired. BEIJOCA saved ground to no avail. RAVE REVIEWS was allowed to settle, offered a mild bid four wide on the second turn but came up empty in the drive. WINTER'S CHILD contended between horses, lacked room leaving the second turn and into the stretch and flattened in the final furlong. SLANDER showed little.
