Footnotes

WELCOME ABOARD stalked the pace four wide, ranged up to join the leaders leaving the turn, poked her head in front nearing the furlong marker, drifted in and bumped MAME'S FLAME with a furlong to run, was straightened away and edged clear late. STORM OF ENERGY broke awkwardly, moved up between horses, worked her way to the outside midway through the turn, came five wide and continued on willingly to earn the place. MAME'S FLAME set the pressured pace three wide, was collared leaving the turn, was headed and bumped in mid stretch when WELCOME ABOARD came in, weakened slightly but had enough left to preserve the show. TIPTHETROLLEYGIRL attended the pace along the inside, lacked room in traffic near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted out and came again between horses, was put in tight and steadied with a furlong to run, altered course to the outside and kept on despite the rough go. THE CAT'S MINE disputed the pace along the inside, was caught in tight near the furlong marker, steadied and went evenly thereafter. J JETT brushed the gate to get away slow, was unhurried into stride, angled out to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. CHAPTER BOOK was slow into stride and was never a factor. The jockey of TIPTHETROLLEYGIRL lodged an objection against WELCOME ABOARD for alleged interference near the eighth pole, following a Stewards review, WELCOME ABOARD was disqualified from first and placed fourth.
