**Footnotes**

MR. JEEVES close up inside, was boxed in around the second turn, angled out entering the stretch, challenged with a furlong to go and drew clear under steady urging. RIVENDELL close up off the rail, lost position in traffic on the second turn, moved to the rail entering the stretch then finished willingly while working his way out inside the final furlong to be up for the place. CONSERVATIVE VALUE closest to the pace off the inside, challenged with a half mile to go, battled into the final furlong and held on gamely. DREAMS CUT SHORT reserved inside, waited on the second turn, angled out for the drive and made a late gain on the outside. TRUE BEE set the pace inside, responded willingly when challenged with a furlong to go, held on well to inside the final furlong and weakened. SKY ALERT reserved three wide, moved out to the five path on the second turn and lacked a late bid. AGENT DI NOZZO within striking distance four wide, stayed in the path on the second turn and failed to respond in the stretch. CHIN THE MOON forwardly placed three wide, tired. E WALD reserved early, raced in the four path on the second turn, waited midway through that turn, angled out for the drive but could not threaten.
