COULEE, inside early, moved out four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace in hand, took over just before going six furlongs, edged clear and was kept to her task. MISS ABITA gained the lead at the start, raced inside, lost the advantage to SWEETBRIAR ACADEMY, fell back a bit on the far turn, continued three wide and was clearly second best. NORMANDY QUEEN, outrun to the far turn, made a steady run five wide leaving the quarter-mile ground and was slowly gaining at the end. LEMONADE moved in behind foes early, inched forward entering the far turn, maneuvered five wide to make a solid run into the final furlong but failed to sustain the needed momentum. LUXURIOUS LADY stalked the pace four wide and weakened approaching the stretch. SWEETBRIAR ACADEMY pressed the pace at once, gained a slim lead before going a half three wide, lost the edge to the winner on the far turn and gradually weakened. WITCHES FUHRY settled in behind horses early, eased out five wide on the far turn but never fired. PILAF was outrun.
