Footnotes

SAHMA TIME settled near the inside early, advanced between foes three or four wide on the far turn, came out five or six wide for the drive, gained command when roused and was gathered up very late. THE COLOR RED, never far back, moved four or five wide nearing the lane, was bumped by MORE THAN RISKY at the three-sixteenths pole when that one came out, then wasn't a match for the winner while clearly superior to the others. RIGHT ON TRACK ducked out into O MOON at the start, was unhurried for six furlongs while three wide, maneuvered six wide when straightened for the drive and bested the others. MORE THAN RISKY hopped at the break to immediately trail, rushed to the front, raced two or three wide, came out bumping THE COLOR RED while tiring in the upper stretch and was finished. O MOON, slammed at the start by RIGHT ON TRACK when that one ducked out, failed to rally. PEWTERELO, well placed near the inside, weakened approaching the final quarter. DEVIOUS DEE tired entering the far turn. HOLY DIXIE chased the pace four wide for five furlongs and weakened gradually.
