Footnotes

FUNKY PIRATE settled in behind foes early, came out between horses five wide entering the stretch and drove clear late under hand urging. TAYLOR'S DAY, well placed in behind the dueling leaders from early on, moved four wide when rallied and couldn't match strides with the winner late. MOMENT OF SONG gained a narrow lead three wide early, was headed briefly on the turn from the outside by RAINBOW BOY, regained the advantage in the upper stretch but weakened late. TEE TO GREEN, within striking distance always, advanced six or seven wide into the lane and managed a mild gain. RAINBOW BOY went up to vie for the lead early while five wide, briefly reached the front on the turn but tired entering the lane. FORCE FORTY NINE, six wide, never fired. ISLAND N ABREEZE never reached contention. STARSHIP RAINBOW was near the inside most of the way and never a factor. JIMMY JONES raced forwardly near the inside for three furlongs and weakened. RESURRECT was outrun.
