Footnotes

BARGAINWITHTHDEVIL, well placed in behind the dueling leaders to the stretch, maneuvered four wide into the stretch, gained a slim lead, then was fully extended to hold sway. BILLYBECK, outrun near the inside to the stretch, eased out five wide at the eighth pole and was going well at the end. SHOCK N STORM attended the pace inside from the start, battled with PRINCE ORO while inside that one, gained a slight edge in the lane, then wasn't quite good enough. BOBBY JACK, within striking distance and near the inside, was empty when straightened into the lane. TROY'S HONOR, five or six wide while within striking distance to the stretch, weakened in the drive. FLORIDA'S QUIXOTE tired inside on the turn. PRINCE ORO gained a slight edge early while dueling three or four wide, battled with SHOCK N STORM while outside that one and weakened upon going a half.
