LAVA FIRE broke a bit slow, was unhurried into stride, circled five wide to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. ANGELS CAN BE WILD set the pressured pace along the inside, but weakened entering the stretch and faded. LEMON CRUNCH settled saving ground, shifted out leaving the second turn and finished with a mild rally. MAKIN SOME BUCKS was through early.
