Footnotes

BRILLIANT ASSET, lightly rated early while there or four wide, moved four or five wide while advancing into the stretch, then held sway under strong hand urging. DASHING GIRL, well placed inside, saved ground for three-quarters, came out from between foes, moved menacingly five wide but wasn't good enough. BEE LINE GENIUS, unhurried early, made a run five or six wide into the stretch, loomed a threat into the last eighth but came up empty. BROAD BREADTH stalked the pace four wide until approaching the stretch and tired. WAVERLY GOLD moved inside but failed to menace while improving position. ISN'T SHE GREAT gained the lead early, moved near the inside, made the pace for nearly six furlongs and tired. RAAH, six wide most of the way, tired leaving the backstretch.
