**Footnotes**

PAYROLL CLERK went up to battle for the lead early while between foes, gained a slight edge, moved clear into the stretch, then was kept to his task to hold sway. SWEET TAFFY, outrun for a half, came out from between horses seven wide for the drive and was going well at the end. WYNN SEEKER angled in early, forced the pace five wide, continued forwardly into the final furlong and faltered. BEACH BERTIE leaned in bumping IMADEITMOM soon after the start, bobbed, raced near the inside and offered a mild gain. INDIAN CHARMER contested the pace inside from early on, raced close up into the stretch and weakened. TATTERED LACE, within striking distance throughout, failed to rally. WISHING ZONE bobbed at the break, angled in four wide to force the pace from between foes and weakened in the drive. LADY WILL POWER came out at the start exchanging bumps with IMADEITMOM and failed to menace. IMADEITMOM bumped first with BEACH BERTIE, then LADY WILLPOWER soon after the start and never reached contention. BIXBY, bumped at the start, raced in contention six wide to the stretch and tired. NO KOWTOWING came out at the start bumping BIXBY and was never prominent. ONYA faded inside on the turn.
