DON'T PUT IT BACK attended the pace along the inside early, steadied near the seven-sixteenths marker, angled out and advanced from between horses through the turn, came three wide and poked his head in front with a furlong to run, was suddenly clear when COPPERHEAD SLINGER broke stride nearing the sixteenth pole and maintained a safe advantage. EDDIE SET GO was slow into stride, made a steady advance circling five wide and was along in time to earn the place. COPPERHEAD SLINGER disputed the pace three wide from between horses through the turn, then along the inside entering the stretch, jumped tracks inside the furlong marker nearly unseating his rider, had his jockey lose both irons but continued on fairly well to hold the show. BAIL BABY BAIL settled saving ground, steadied from tight quarters just inside the half mile marker, shifted out and made a mild rally three wide but failed to seriously threaten. CHEQUE APPEAL lunged at the start, rushed up to vie for the lead from between horses, but came up empty after a half and gave way. GREEN N GOLDIE prompted the pace three wide, faltered from between horses leaving the turn and dropped out, following the race GREEN N GOLDIE was unsaddled on the turn and vanned off.
