MINTS N THE VALLEY opened clear to dictate terms and remained unchallenged. BUTCHSKI stalked the pace three deep, launched her bid entering the stretch, was no match for the winner, then was all out to hold the place. JOYOUS VICTORY was unhurried into stride, split horses to commence her bid, made a long drive five wide and was making up ground. HARMONY HEAVEN settled in the second flight five wide, moved up to make a mild bid leaving the second turn but failed to sustain the drive. LA BOHEMIA was unhurried into stride, advanced between horses through the second turn and the stretch and improved position. HISPANIA saved ground, angled out to make a belated gain but was never a factor. MISSYBOBABY failed to respond. LADY AMIRA chased the pace three wide to the stretch and tired. SUSIE'S SURPRISE pulled to contention four wide, but came up empty after five furlongs and retreated. BLIND AS A BAT raced wide throughout and passed only the tiring ones. GENEVIEVE LADY was through after a half. SILVER HALLMARK jumped tracks near the wire first time past, had the saddle slip and was rank to place five wide, worked her way back to last through the second turn, unseated the jockey

near the quarter pole but walked off.
