Footnotes

CHASEUR outsprinted early, made a run three wide on the turn, caught the leaders near the sixteenth marker despite being carried out a bit by DOUBLY HARD and drew clear late. DOUBLY HARD drifted out at the start bothering outer rivals, was straightened, forced the pace three wide, challenged before a half, drifted out in midstretch, drifted back in approaching the furlong marker placing SUAVE in tight, then held on for the place while drifted out late carrying that same rival out. SUAVE behind the leaders off the inside, steadied when attempting to split the leaders nearing the sixteenth marker, recovered and held on gamely despite being carried out late. MAN OF CONQUEST set the pace off the inside, responded willingly when challenged on the turn, held on well to inside the final furlong, drifted out a bit nearing the sixteenth marker and weakened. LEADING OFF broke in the air and then lost his footing recovering, was carried out soon after, was allowed to settle, raced four wide on the turn and finished with good determination. TRUTHFUL HEART within striking distance off the rail, tired in the drive. DANCEMAKER broke in the air, was carried out after recovering, was outrun and never threatened. WAVING MONARCH carried out at the start, was no factor. GIBBAR five wide into the turn, could not menace. BINGOBEAR within striking distance, saved ground on the turn and stopped. Following a stewards inquiry, DOUBLY HARD was disqualified and placed third for interference in the stretch.
