MAZEL TOV reserved early, angled out five wide late on the second turn when rallying and closed well to be up in time. QUICK ADVICE alternated for the lead between rivals, drew clear in midstretch but was outfinished. LIKE TO DO forced the pace three wide and held on gamely. MY PRECIOUS INDIAN within striking distance, steadied near the quarter mile marker when advancing off the inside, angled out for the drive but lacked a late bid. ERICKA'S EYES outrun early, made a mild gain five wide passing the three furlong marker but could not sustain the bid and was no threat. CARLISLE outrun near the inside, made a late bid. NUMERUS REASONS alternated for the lead along the inside and tired. NEVERDID was no threat. MY SKIPPY BEAR four wide on the first turn wen behind the leaders, faded. SHELL IN THE SAND faded.
