Footnotes

TIZTHEMANINTHEMOON, up close between foes early, raced under light rating, reached the front nearing the lane, lost the edge to PERRY in mid-stretch, then dug in gamely in the late going to come again and capture a narrow decision. SNOOSE GOOSE settled in behind foes early, came out on the far turn to make a sweeping six wide run, loomed boldly and was outfinished. OLD MAN BUCK broke to the inside, settled behind horses, came out between foes five or six wide in the late going and finished full of run. PERRY forced the pace from the outset, gained a slim lead, battled up close into deep stretch and grudgingly weakened. PULASKI COUNTY, well placed three wide to the stretch, weakened thereafter. LAYSH LAYSH LAYSH followed the leaders in a striking position five or six wide and tired. MEISTERWERK never was prominent. BOOKER was outrun. CLOD BUSTER raced near the inside and weakened after five furlongs. CHARLIE'S ACADEMY gained the lead inside early, lost the edge to PERRY before going a half and gave way steadily on the far turn.
