Footnotes

ABIERTO LA PUERTA settled near the inside early, moved between foes four wide on the far turn, came a bit wider into the stretch and was hard ridden to prevail. CABERNEIGH, bumped lightly at the start by CATALEX, was never far back, moved four wide entering the upper stretch, had aim in the late going and wasn't good enough. DOODLEBURG settled three wide in hand, came out six wide for the stretch run and managed a mild gain. BEACH DEPUTY, reserved near the inside early, trailed to the stretch, advanced between horses into the lane and improved position. CATALEX came out at the start bumping CABERNEIGH, moved up to vie for the lead three abreast soon after, took over, was clear into the stretch and faltered. PULPIT'S JET forced the pace four wide to the stretch and weakened. PETE'S PRIDE vied for the lead from between foes early, continued forwardly to the far turn and couldn't keep pace.
