STAKES Cliff Guilliams Memorial S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. Free nomination, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry by payment of \$2,500 (includes entry and starting fees). \$50,000 Guaranteed. The Association's money to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes on the turf allowed 2 lbs., three races other than maiden or claiming allowed 4 lbs., two races other than maiden or claiming allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. If the race is moved to the main track after the time of closing, a horse may be scratched for any reason at any time up to fifteen (15) minutes prior to post time for the race preceding this race or thereafter with a valid physical reason and approved by the stewards. The entry fee and the supplementary nomination fee if applicable shall be refunded for scratches made in compliance with the above conditions. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Saturday, July 19, 2008 with 24 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One mile out of the chute.)

Footnotes

CHEROKEE TRIANGLE settled in hand four wide, launched his bid entering the lane, was carried out inside the sixteenth pole when I. M. BOOMER veered out, but continued on willingly and wore down VEILED PROPHET in the final strides. VEILED PROPHET angled in to save ground, responded when roused near the three-eighths pole, came four wide to make a bold bid, forged a clear lead entering the stretch, continued on willingly but was denied in the last jump. EL ALEMAN was shuffled back at the start and unhurried into stride, made a late rally circling the field, finished full of run on the outside and was gaining with every stride. I. M. BOOMER sped clear to dictate terms, was collared entering the lane, veered out when displaced by the runner up and roused left handed, dropped back a bit then was coming again late. OLD MAN BUCK was bumped entering the first turn, settled in hand from between horses, made a mild bid entering the stretch, but checked slightly when CHEROKEE TRIANGLE was forced out and went evenly thereafter. TANALIAN rushed to contention from between horses bumping OLD MAN BUCK, attended the pace for six furlongs and faded. INDEPENDENCE WAR saved ground to little avail. DOCTOR CAL chased the pace three wide for six furlongs and tired. CRIMSON COMIC was pinched back and steadied off heels entering the first turn, veered out losing ground and never recovered.
