Footnotes

HARK stalked the pace along the inside, slipped through to make her bid leaving the second turn, forged a clear lead and increased her advantage. MISS DOCTOR TY settled in hand from between horses, closed the gap through the second turn, checked slightly nearing the quarter pole, split horses entering the stretch angled in and finished willingly to earn the place. CRYSTAL MINUET was unhurried early, made a steady advance four wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. HOUR QUEEN settled saving ground, got through to make a late rally, but failed to seriously threaten. WEEKEND CONNECTION was allowed to settle into stride, came four wide to make a mild bid, but failed to sustain the drive. ALLEGED DIVA was unhurried early, made a mild rally four wide but was never a factor. PRESS LEAK chased the pace three wide, but faltered from between horses leaving the second turn and faded. WILLOW CREEK was hustled along four wide in the second flight and failed to respond. LA DURAN dueled for the lead two wide for six furlongs and dropped out. CROWD DIVA dueled for the lead along the inside, steadied off heels near the quarter pole and stopped.
