Footnotes

RAINBOW'S SECRET set the pace along the inside, repelled the challenge of GERIVELLO with a furlong to run and gamely led throughout. The latter tracked the pace two wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch, was unable to match strides with the winner but continued on willingly to clearly prove second best. CATCH THE PRIZE settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch and was along for the show. CONSIDER THEMAX made a steady advance circling six wide and improved her position. SUNNYWAY was hustled along in the second flight from between horses, offered a mild bid leaving the turn but failed to sustain the drive. PROSPECTOR MATTIE was allowed to settle, came four wide to make a mild rally but failed to threaten. NEVAEH'S SONG saved ground to little avail. UMMA UMMA was slow into stride, came five wide but failed to respond. BRINEY was through after a half. SHE'S DUE FOR ONE threw her head behind the divider at the start, was hung up in the gate and left at the post. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the start, and following the review SHE'S DUE FOR ONE was declared an official starter.
