### Footnotes

MONTREAL'S BEST gained the lead early, edged clear approaching the stretch, widened under mild hand urging and was gathered up late as much the best. TECHNO VISION, within easy striking distance and saving ground into the lane, angled four or five wide at the furlong grounds and was fully extended to earn second. BIRDIE PUTT, never far back while between foes four wide, came up empty the last eighth. SPECIAL INSIGNIA, well placed in behind the leaders to the stretch, held her position while unable to offer a closing bid. COURTYARD BARBI tracked the pace five wide into the stretch and flattened out when the test came. OUR CAROL failed to menace. KAT CAN DANCE never was prominent. LACE AND LIGHTNING was outrun.
