tASHLEY AND I drifted out a the start bumping BOJANGLE'S CAT, chased front-running BLACK TOPPER four wide and wore him down under steady urging. BLACK TOPPER gained the lead three wide, was clear into the final furlong and had no mishap while unable to last. PRESIDENT'S WOMAN, outrun to the stretch and in behind horses, circled seven or eight wide into the lane and finished willingly. A LITTLE GOLD, outsprinted early, raced three or four wide and managed a mild gain. ARTFUL LAUNCH stalked the pace four or five wide to the stretch and weakened. BOJANGLE'S CAT, bumped at the start by the winner, was steadied and forced out, then never seriously menaced. CLEVER FANCY raced off the inside within striking distance to the stretch and faded.
