TRANSMIT, reserved near the inside early and never far back, eased out five or six wide approaching the stretch, wrested command and drew off under mild urging as much the best. PAY THE TOLL, well positioned while between foes three or four wide, was no match for the winner as second best. SUPPLE, unhurried early, advanced steadily five wide on the far turn, fell back in the upper stretch, then improved position at the end while no threat to the top two. OELECTRA forced the pace four or five wide into the final furlong and flattened out. MINNEHAHA CHIC tracked the pace four or five wide and was empty when the test came. HONORABLE CRUSADER hopped at the start, was outrun to the lane and passed tired foes. WINNER'S HIGH gained a clear lead while moving inside early, made the pace to the stretch and weakened. A. P. ENGLISH never was close. PILLOW LADY, well placed five wide early, drifted out eight wide entering the backstretch, then bore out badly at the quarter-mile ground.
