Footnotes

NATALICAT sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace near the rail and held sway under pressure. MISS ABITA forwardly placed off the rail, challenged before a half, dropped back a bit into the stretch then was coming again late. LUCKY APPROVAL close up inside, moved off the rail, angled out a bit for the drive but lacked the needed closing bid. ASTUTE LADY outrun early along the inside, advanced along the inside into the stretch and made a late gain. PERFECK CONNECT never far back, made an inside middle move but had no late bid. STRIKING JEAN reserved early, raced three wide on the second turn and lodged a mild late bid. FAST ACTRESS close up early three wide, challenged before a half, held on well to the stretch and tired. TRIO outrun early, raced four wide into the stretch and could not threaten. TARTUFI was no factor four wide. SILVER INDIAN within striking distance early, faded.
