SAFFRON HALL set the pace, raced off the inside on the second turn when managing a short lead, responded in the stretch and drew clear under steady urging. C FOR CHANT prompted the pace from the start, raced in the three path on the second turn, was no match for the winner in the final furlong but held on to be second best. PORTMAN outrun early, raced in the four path on the second turn and was no threat late. BOLTED MAGIC forwardly placed from the start, moved out three wide with three furlongs to go and had nothing left late. MAGELLAN within striking distance along the inside, tired. MAC DARA failed to menace. CRISTOVIA forwardly placed early three wide, faded. ZAPATON outrun, could not keep pace and was outdistanced.
