Footnotes

BABY GIRL MALIA, reserved early three wide, edged closer when moving between horses on the far turn, angled five wide for the drive, reached the front a furlong out and drove clear under urging. A FEW Z'S, well placed between rivals early, raced three or four wide, moved inside on the far turn, split foes three wide for the drive and was second best. NESSY'S GIRL gained the lead inside early, made the pace into the lane and weakened. MAKINGTHEGRADE, unhurried early, improved position in the drive but wasn't a serious threat. MISS JEANNIE G. stalked the pace four or five wide to the stretch and weakened. SCOTLAND PLACE raced in contention to the stretch while five or six wide and tired. OBRIEN, edgy in the gate prior to the start, pressed front-running NESSY'S GIRL four wide to the stretch and tired. DECKER CHAPEL never menaced and was five or six wide throughout. HE SHALL REIGN raced forwardly near the inside for a half and tired.
