PROSPECTIVE SAINT closest to the pace, challenged with a half mile to go and proved best under steady urging. MAGGIE SLEW set the pace along the inside, responded willingly when challenged by the winner and held on gamely. PLAID within striking distance off the inside, lacked a closing bid. CHARACTER BUILDER six wide early when gaining position, raced forwardly thereafter, was in the four path on the second turn and went evenly late. FAST NAVY (BRZ) bobbled after the start, was reserved, raced four wide on the second turn and lodged a mild late bid. STARRY PIE well back early, made a good middle move but had nothing left late. FLY AWAY ANGEL outrun early, improved her position but could not menace. TEN CARAT RUBY unhurried along the inside, was no threat. BEAU WATCH five wide early when moving to a forward position, held well to the stretch and faded. SEA SIREN within striking distance three wide, gave way.
