TIS A MAN reserved along the inside, was patiently ridden around the turn, angled out after being blocked in upper stretch, drifted out under left handed pressure inside the final furlong then rallied willingly to dead heat HADACURE. HADACURE pressed the pace three wide, drew clear inside the final furlong then held on gamely to finish on even terms with TIS A MAN. WESTERN PRIZE reserved early, attempted to drift out after a half, came to the outside for the drive, was carried out inside the final furlong then finished willingly late. COMMANDER CARSON close up, challenged between rivals with three furlongs to go, held on well to midstretch and weakened. DA BADA BING set the pace along the inside, stayed on well to the stretch and tired. TROPHY ROAD within striking distance three wide, moved four wide late on the turn but lacked a closing bid. NEED MONEY DAD never far back, steadied in traffic near the five furlong marker, recovered, held on well to the final quarter and tired. A FOUL CLAIM BY THE RIDER OF HADACURE AGAINST THE RIDER OF TIS A MAN FOR INTERFERENCE WAS NOT ALLOWED. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY, TIS A MAN WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED THIRD FOR INTERFERING WITH WESTERN PRIZE IN THE STRETCH.
