Footnotes

EBONEY OYNX, forwardly placed, was angled out for the drive and wore down SLEW EM BERTI. The latter sprinted clear to set the pace but could not hold the winner safe late. TAFFY, angled out four wide leaving the turn, rallied. COPPER BLAZE stumbled at the start, moved quickly to a forward position but lacked a late bid. RANAES PISTOL, within striking distance, raced four wide on the turn and tired. SILVER UP UNDER tired from her early efforts. WHISKEY TROUBLE was outrun. CHEROKEE RAIN, forwardly placed, raced four wide on the turn and faded. THREEWATERSRUNNING was outrun. MISS NEVADA faded after three furlongs. MENDOTA was always outrun. Heavy rain made it impossible to distinguish between horses at the first point of call.
