PATRIOTIC FEVER gained the lead early, raced three wide, came out a bit farther on the track for the drive and was kept to her task to hold sway. HAUNTING REFRAIN, never far back, raced in behind the leaders to the stretch, angled five wide for the drive, loomed outside the winner through the drive and wasn't good enough. FORMAL TRICKS, well placed inside throughout, was empty the last eighth. SARINA'S PRINCESS bobbed at the start, was outsprinted to the lane, made a mild bid nearing the final furlong but failed to continue. BLUE'S FIRST BABY stalked the pace five wide into the final furlong and came up empty. VIVIAN'S AMOUR, outrun to the stretch, passed tired foes. SURPRISE CALL swerved out and bobbed at the start, then failed to rally. MY BLONDY LADY, outrun to the stretch, never threatened while improving position. WHAT A COOK faded leaving the turn. GOLDEN BEE raced forwardly between foes four wide to the stretch and faltered. A TIMELESS LADY was done early. KIM'S ATTITUDE was outrun.
