Footnotes

CLEARLY BEST within striking distance three wide, responded in the stretch and wore down the leader. BOLD PEAKS pressed the pace off the inside, challenged in earnest after a half, gained a short lead for the drive but missed. TAUPO behind the leaders along the inside, angled out three wide leaving the second turn when moving to the leaders but lacked a late bid. ATLANTIC GALE within striking distance four wide, tired. HEAVENLY OIL set a pressured pace along the inside and gave way.
