SODA POP TOP sprinted clear early, raced in the three path, then was fully extended to last. PRINCESS IRIS settled four wide, came out seven wide at the quarter-mile ground, angled in when straightened for the drive, was going well at the end and missed. HERS FUNNY stalked the winner four or five wide and came up empty the last eighth. LIT'L NANCY'S GIRL, well placed between foes three or four wide to the stretch, weakened in the drive. ACE'S NELL, in contention three or four wide, failed to rally. MISS JOSEY B, outrun to the stretch, improved position but couldn't threaten. WHO FIRED WHO faded inside on the turn. IDALOU, checked after the start, failed to menace. REMIES, unruly in the gate prior to the start, was outrun.
