FIDGITY FELON vied for the lead three wide, shook clear entering the stretch, and maintained a diminishing advantage. JAKE'S SOLDIER disputed the pace along the inside, shifted out for the final furlong, came again and was getting to the winner. CRYPTO GULCH was allowed to settle, came five wide to make his bid, but found his best stride too late. BE A PRINCE settled saving ground, got through to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. HONOR PURSUIT pressed the pace between horses, but drifted out leaving the turn and faded. THIS CAT'S BEST broke a step slow and was never a factor.
