Footnotes

CRACKALACKIN prompted the pace three wide, forged a narrow lead leaving the turn, opened clear through the upper stretch, then was kept to task to prevail. CLASSIC ROBBERY stalked the pace along the inside, waited in traffic leaving the turn, angled out to find room nearing the furlong marker, and finished with a rush once clear. GRUENEWALD settled racing in hand, came four wide to make a late rally and was along for the show. BOOT SCOOTIN BABY angled in and disputed the pace for five furlongs and weakened. SON OF THE WEST broke a step slow, advanced for a contending position from between horses, but was caught in tight nearing the furlong marker and retreated. ALABAMA VOW was away slowly and showed little.
