Footnotes

GUYS REWARD within striking distance between rivals, was in tight midway through the second turn, angled out for the drive and closed well to be up in time. CODOY within striking distance three wide, moved up four wide late on the second turn and finished willingly between horses to miss. MICKEJOE close up along the inside, angled out a bit for the drive, challenged late but also missed. HARRODS CREEK reserved along the inside, made a good middle move off the inside then finished well inside the leaders. BULLETPROOF SPIRIT four wide early, forced the pace throughout and battled to the finish. LOUIE MONDELLO alternated for the lead three wide early, angled in a bit on the backstretch, raced with the pace into deep stretch and held on gamely. REWARDABLE outrun to the stretch, could not menace. FLEETING WILL was no threat. CONSULATE reserved along the inside, was no factor. LONOMAKUA was outrun. HOLLAND AND RIEMAN five wide into the first turn, prompted the pace for a half and stopped.
