PROPER SIX, never far back, rallied six wide into the stretch, lugged in at the eighth pole when clear or rivals and won going away under lefthanded urging. DEVIL ANSE, jolted at the start from the inside by PARTY TO REMEMBER, gained a slight edge soon after while dueling outside of TIFFANY'S TREASURE, shook off that one, then failed to contain the winner late. JULIET'S POISON, outrun until the stretch while saving ground, angled four wide between rivals to rally and finished willingly. PARTY TO REMEMBER ducked out at the start bumping DEVIL ANSE, raced within easy striking distance and failed to rally. TIFFANY'S TREASURE went up to vie for the lead inside DEVIL ANSE early, held on well until the stretch and weakened. VIRTUAL G stalked the leaders five wide into the stretch and flattened out. SMARTY ATTHE PARTY failed to rally in an even effort. TOCA ARAKEN wasn't a factor. BULLY BULLY, sluggish and awkward at the start, was outrun. CAMPERCHANO was done early. BETT'S BUGLE BOY was outrun as was RADIO FREQUENCY.
