Footnotes

DYNASURE gained the lead early while a bit off the inside, showed the way from the three path, then drew off in the final furlong under energetic handling. JAZZ TRADITION, never far back, raced between foes four of five wide, was just off the winner for the last eighth but couldn't menace as second best. RE LYD, outrun for a half, made a five wide run approaching the stretch and couldn't seriously menace at the end while slightly improving position. DONANDRU'S DREAM, near the inside, failed to rally. KAYLAN'S ROSE, well placed inside from the start, angled four wide approaching the stretch, was just off the winner and flattened out. OUR FREYA failed to reach serious contention while passing tired foes. CHORUS GIRL, outrun to the stretch, improved position but couldn't threaten. DEVANT angled in early to force the issue five wide, held on well for six furlongs and tired. JADESTER, four or five wide, and well placed to the far turn, weakened nearing the stretch. DANCE TO DAWN faded inside leaving the backstretch. SKRATE stumbled at the start and unseated the rider.
