Footnotes

ALANDTOM settled in hand, advanced between rivals, split horses four wide entering the stretch, forged command with a furlong to run then was all out to just last. SILVERADO BEACH was unhurried into stride, commenced his rally with three furlongs to run, weaved through traffic, shifted out and was gaining with every stride. POTENTIAL PLUS was close up two wide, weakened in the final furlong but had enough left to hold the show. FREE SHIPPING opened clear to set the pace, was collared entering the stretch and faltered in the final furlong. RESTLESS DREAMS was allowed to settle, angled out to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. RANGO contended between horses through the second turn and tired. MONASHEE VISION contended three wide to the stretch and faded. WHO DAT FANS was hustled along five wide for six furlongs and dropped out. WOUND UP showed little. FIVE STAR DEBT was forwardly placed to the second turn along the inside and stopped. D'ARIO was outrun. HOWIE ROLL unseated the jockey and ran off for a quarter mile prior to the race, hopped at the start and was never a factor.
