MEOUSER dropped back along the inside early, waited off the rail with three furlongs to go, angled out four wide entering the stretch, reeled in the leader and edged off late. OL ARMY sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace inside, responded willingly when challenged on the second turn, battled into the final furlong and held on gamely. LUZIANNA MAN reserved five wide, made a good four wide move after a half, challenged approaching the stretch but tired late. E. M. MAXIMUS close up off the rail, raced along the inside into the second turn, came off the rail to challenge approaching the stretch but gave way. PICKY PICKY outrun early, raced in the four path on the second turn and could not threaten. RIDE THE LIGHTNING reserved in the three path, raced four wide on the second turn and could not menace. CHEYENNE PASS was no factor. DOOYA forwardly placed early four wide, stopped. CHEERS AND BEERS close up off the rail, moved out a path on the second turn and stopped.
