Footnotes

GLORIOUS GIRL gained the advantage near the inside early, raced in hand while accomplishing slow fractions, spurted clear in the upper stretch, then lasted under urging. ROYAL DAZZLE, in hand and near the inside, saved ground into the lane, angled four wide in the final furlong and was gaining late. WISE INVESTOR pressed the winner in hand through slow fractions, loomed prominently entering the upper stretch but came up empty. CALL ME EPPI, within easy striking distance and four or five wide, lacked a closing kick. EVER BRILLIANT, reserved early and five or six wide most of the way, made a run at the quarter-mile ground but flattened out when straightened for the drive. CASE CHASER, unhurried near the inside for six furlongs, eased out four wide for the drive but never fired. DIVA, within easy striking distance while rated along three or four wide, swung six wide into the stretch but was empty.
