SATURDAY LAUNCH settled in hand, split horses to make his bid, shook clear and widened. DOWNTOWN DRIGGS was allowed to settle, came five wide and was all out to earn the place. MARCO'S BON VIVANT was unhurried into stride, circled six wide to make a bold bid but failed to sustain the drive. GOSPEL HOUR pulled to contention off of the inside, was bottled up through the second turn, steadied near the quarter pole, shifted out six wide but lacked the needed late response. GRANDSTAND was unhurried into stride, swung seven wide entering the stretch and improved position. C FOR CHANT was slow into stride, settled saving ground, angled out and finished with a belated gain. ATLANTIC DANCER was allowed to settle, made a mild gain four wide but failed to threaten. D' WILDCAT ROAD dueled for the lead two wide to the stretch and faded. ALEXANDER THEGREAT dueled for the lead along the inside, but came up empty leaving the second turn and retreated. OPERATIVE ASSETS chased the pace four wide for six furlongs and dropped out. KIRGHIZ showed little. GREAT LIFE was through early.
