TAP MAGIC sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace near the rail, drew off into the stretch and was not menaced while kept to the task. TROIS FAMILLE within striking distance off the inside, lodged a mild bid for the place. KAZOOM close up along the inside, lacked a closing bid. VERY SPECIAL LADY outrun early three wide, moved out five wide with three furlongs to go and was no threat. HANKERING within reach four wide, stayed in that path on the second turn and tired. PLAIN AND SIMPLE forwardly placed, lost position in traffic near the three furlong marker and was no threat. DARE RIDGE close up off the inside, faded in the drive.
