STRUTTIN' gained a slight edge inside early, was headed on the backstretch from the outside by COOKIE BIGHT COVE, regained the advantage and gamely withstood HALODRAMATIC to earn a close decision. HALODRAMATIC tracked the pace from early on while four wide, gained near even terms with the winner while outside that one entering the lane but couldn't get past as second best. NATIVE FEVER, never far back, swung out five wide leaving the second turn, had aim in the drive but lacked a final account. INTREPID QUEEN, outrun early, reached easy striking distance nearing the final quarter but could gain only slightly at the end. LOUISIANA SKY broke slowly and awkwardly, was checked, made a run to reach contention five wide after seven furlongs but lacked a further account. COOKIE BIGHT COVE attended the pace between foes from early on, headed the winner on the backstretch, continued forwardly to the lane and tired. MY PRECIOUS INDIAN failed to menace. SHELL IN THE SAND stalked the pace to the far turn and tired. CYA SAL took a bad step just before going a half and was puled up lame.
