QUITE A PARTY, never far back and five wide, inched to challenge nearing the final quarter, then was under pressure to out-game DO NOT PASS in a long drive. DO NOT PASS, up close four wide, gained even terms for the lead entering the lane, then wasn't quite good enough. MON CABO, well placed inside early, lost position on the far turn when steadied behind rivals, remained inside when put to a drive, worked her way out six wide about the sixteenth pole and wasn't good enough. TENAFLY gained the lead inside early, made the pace into the final furlong and weakened grudgingly. LAZY SAHANA, outrun to the lane, made a run to reach contention nearing the final furlong but failed to continue. VICE ORR VERSA, outrun to the stretch, improved position but couldn't menace. MAYBE KATIE weakened approaching the stretch. UNZIPPER forced the pace for a half and faded soon after. BARBATINA raced inside, was well placed for six furlongs and flattened out.
