Footnotes

DUAL FORECAST settled in hand toward the inside through the first turn, worked his way to the outside on the backstretch, ranged up four wide to make a bold bid, kicked clear entering the stretch and maintained a safe advantage. TWILIGHT BAY was unhurried into stride, moved up five wide through the second turn, loomed large entering the stretch but was unable to reach the winner. ED'S BIG BET was unhurried along the inside through the opening five furlongs, commenced his bid on the second turn, angled out and came five wide into the stretch, finished fairly well and was along for the show. THUNDER HIGHWAY tracked the pace along the inside, forged a narrow lead nearing the five-sixteenths pole, but weakened during the drive and gave way. JACK IN THE PULPIT opened clear to set the pace, but faltered before going six furlongs and faded. ZEKE'S MOON saved ground to little avail. STENSON PARK failed to respond. VAGUELY A SAINT passed only the tiring ones. RAMBLING WRECK contended between horses to the second turn and faltered. TORVALD showed little in a dull effort.
