BAILOUT KID set the pressured pace three deep between horses, shook clear entering the stretch and maintained a safe advantage. TRICKY TOKYO settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch to launch his bid, shifted out with a sixteenth to run and finished willingly to earn the place. RULER NEKIA broke in the air, rushed to contention along the inside, steadied off heels near the seven-sixteenths pole, came again readily through the turn, swung eight wide leaving the turn, drifted out further through the drive but stayed on well despite trouble to hold the show. DICTUM was hustled along five wide to attend the pace, waited in traffic leaving the turn, finished with a mild gain and improved position. WRIGHT TRIBUTE prompted the pace four wide to the final furlong and faded. INCREDIBLY GIFTED vied for the lead off of the inside to the furlong marker and gave way. PHONE THE SPIRIT stumbled at the start, was hustled along four wide in mid pack and went evenly. ONE FOR BISCUIT settled in the second flight and failed to respond. BRINDLE RIDGE broke slowly and passed only the tiring ones. THAT TERRIBLETIGER showed little. PRINCE OF DANCE unseated his jockey and ran off loose in post parade just over five-sixteenths of a mile, and was always outrun. QUICK NICK was through early.
