Footnotes

MISS JENNA stalked the pace off of the inside, split horses to make a bold bid, quickly drew clear and held a diminishing advantage. KIDDING was allowed to settle, ranged into striking distance circling five wide through the second turn, dropped to the inside entering the stretch, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. MISS ROLLINGSTONE attended the pace three wide, moved up four wide through the second turn to make a mild bid, weakened between horses and settled for the minor award. MISS CONGRATS attended the pace along the inside, narrowed the gap through the second turn, steadied off heels inside the five-sixteenths pole, was bumped between horses with a quarter to run, wheeled out five wide but flattened out in the drive. LADY TOCCET settled saving ground, veered out under left handed urging entering the stretch and finished with a mild gain. SORRING TRAIN came five wide and passed the tiring ones. SEPTEMBER JOY was slow into stride, made a mild gain leaving the second turn, was carried out entering the stretch, ducked out inside the sixteenth pole and was never a factor. MENWOLF set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed before going six furlongs and gave way readily thereafter. CLEOTA chased the pace three wide for six furlongs and stopped.
