LA STUPENDA tucked in to save ground, advanced between horses on the second turn, wheeled out seven wide entering the stretch, finished with a rush and edged clear late. SIX STRONG LADY settled saving ground, slipped through entering the stretch, loomed large a furlong out but was unable to match strides with the winner. SWEETS GALORE stalked the pace two wide, came three wide and kept on well to earn the show. SMARTY PARTY stalked the pace along the inside, got through and forged command with a furlong to run but failed to sustain the drive. A NATIONALTREASURE was allowed to settle, finished with a belated gain between horses and improved position. HOLIDAY SOIREE contended between horses but lacked a response when called upon. BE QUIET LADY was unhurried, finished with some run but found her best stride too late. OLD ENGLISH SELENE opened clear to set the pace, disputed the issue to the final furlong and faded. WENDY AND HER CATS pressed the pace two wide to the stretch and dropped out. APRIL SUNSHINE showed little. LILLIAN GISH was never a factor. BIOGIO'S GIFT was hustled along four wide, was carried out by the winner entering the stretch and stopped.
