By subscription of \$100 each to accompany the nomination, \$100 to pass the entry box and \$200 additional to start. \$50,000 added and an additional \$50,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The Association's added money to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. Weight: Three-Year-Olds, 117 lbs. Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 twice in 2004 allowed 2 lbs., Non-winners of a sweepstakes in 2004 allowed 4 lbs., Non-winners of \$30,000 twice since September 1, 2003 allowed 6 lbs. A trophy to the winning owner will be given by the Breeders' Cup Ltd. Nominations closed Saturday, July 31, 2004 with 16 nominations.

MOLTO VITA vied for the lead off the inside, drew clear into the stretch and held sway late. TINA BULL reserved behind the leaders, angled out four wide late on the turn for room and rallied willingly to be slowly getting to the winner. SMOKE CHASER forwardly placed in the four path, lacked the needed closing bid. GOLDEN MARLIN reserved early, angled five wide late on the turn when rallying but hung in the drive. VICKI VALLENCOURT outsprinted early, was six wide late on the turn and was no real threat. HANDPAINTED behind the leaders four wide, tired. STAR OF ATTICUS bobbled at the start, rushed up outside the winner, forced the pace for a half three wide and faded.
