Footnotes

NAPHTALI broke a step slow, tucked in to save ground, pulled to contention along the inside, angled out entering the stretch, split horses and forged command with a furlong to run and steadily drew clear. FELA KUTI opened clear to set the pace along the inside, was collared before going a half, disputed the issue through a long drive, fought on well but was unable to resist the winner late. MAE B TODAY stalked the pace off of the inside, launched his bid three wide, was carried out further entering the stretch, weakened from between horses in the drive and settled for a minor award. WIND OF HEAVEN settled in hand, ranged into striking distance four wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch but lacked the needed late punch. HURRICANE DENTON made an early move between horses to contest for the lead, but drifted out leaving the second turn and weakened during the drive. PALACE CAUSEWAY passed his tiring foes. CLASSIC FRED raced wide throughout and failed to respond. SMOKIN FAST rushed to contention five wide, but came up empty after a half and dropped out.
